Gap Funding:

Financial Support for Families at Start Young Providers



Safety Net

Who: Families encountering a financial setback

- Immigrated to US past 6 mos
- Health issues preventing parent from working
- Lost job and seeking employment
- Loss of family member who financially supports
- Given birth (in past 2 mos)
- Homeless/Temporary housing

What: Monthly payments to centers, renewable up to 3 months

- Infant (0-18mo) = \$800/month
- Toddler (19-30mo) = \$775/month
- Pre-K (31 mo-5yr) = \$575/month

Subsidy Waiting Period*

Who: Families who have applied for DCF child care subsidy, but are waiting to access those funds while their application is approved

What: Monthly payments to centers, renewable up to 3 months, designed to match what subsidy would cover.

- Infant (0-18mo) = \$800/month
- Toddler (19-30mo) = \$775/month
- Pre-K (31mo-5yr) = \$575/month

*Wrap-Around Fee gap funding is available to eligible Head Start and Federal Early Head Start children at a reduced rate.

Supplemental

Who: Families receiving DCF subsidy with additional, demonstrated financial need. Eligibility determined based on # of criteria met:

- 250% of federal poverty limit or lower*
- Eligible for Head Start/EHS, but waiting for a spot
- Have remaining tuition costs higher than \$100/month that subsidy does not cover.

What: Monthly payments to centers, renewable after June 30, 2023

• Infant/Toddler/Pre-K = \$100/month

Children must be 4 years or younger on August 31, 2022 to be eligible for gap funding in this school-year. (Can turn 5 in the school-year, but must not be eligible for Kindergarten.)

Scholarship*

Who: Families whose income is just over the cutoff for the initial DCF subsidy application, but otherwise meet criteria for the subsidy.

- Up to 275% Federal Poverty Limit
- All adults working a minimum of 20 hours weekly
- Denied child care subsidy due to eligibility requirements

What: Monthly payments to centers, renewable after June 30, 2023

Infant (0-18mo) = \$600/month
Toddler (19-30mo) = \$500/month
Pre-K (31mo-5yr) = \$400/month

*Wrap-Around Fee gap funding is available to eligible Head Start and Federal EHS children at reduced rate.

How to Access:

- 1. Family completes gap funding application that applies to their situation, submits via email or mail
- 2. TFC Child Care Subsidy Advocates determine eligibility and confirm enrollment with directors
- 3. If eligible, advocates send an agreement to families and copy directors on the amounts TFC will fund
- 4. If ineligible, advocates contact family and provide other resources as available
- 5. Advocates send invoice(s) to center by 5th of each month, confirming enrollment with directors
- 6. Directors sign invoice(s) by 8th of each month, and payment is distributed by check in the mail
- 7. Advocates meet with families to track progress through goals set at initial meeting
- 8. Directors and families contact advocates when enrollment changes and/or income changes
